

Key Stage One 'Acceptable Use' Agreement

Computers, tablets and the internet form an important part of life. It is important that whilst at school you learn how to use different forms of technology safely and responsibly. These rules are for anytime you use computers, tablets or the internet in school, including playtimes, lunchtimes and before and after school.



This is how we stay safe when we use computers and tablets:

- I will ask a teacher or school adult if I want to use the computers / tablets
- I will only use computers/tablets for tasks a teacher or school adult has allowed me to do
- I will use my own username and password to log on to the computers
- I will not ask to borrow someone else's username and password and I will not let anyone else borrow mine
- I will take care of the computers, tablets and other equipment
- I will ask for help from a teacher or school adult if I am not sure what to do or if I think I have done something wrong
- I will tell a teacher or school adult if I see something that upsets me on the screen
- **I know it is part of the adults in school's job to keep me safe.** I will respect their decisions about what I can or cannot do on a computer or tablet and will ask for help if I am not sure
- I know the school is able to monitor the things I do when using computers and tablets
- I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer / tablet
- I know that if I break the rules I may receive a sanction in school (e.g. thinking time, detention) and my parents/carers may be informed
